About Me

Having been involved in entertainment lighting in the SF Bay Area for over 25 years, I'm now a savvy veteran capable of tackling any task put before me.

Problem Solving is my specialty.

Originally coming out from Connecticut at 17 where I had learned theatrical stagecraft in my early teens. My Film career started at DTC Grip & Electric in Berkeley in 1994. In 2001 I began working through The International Alliance of Theatrical





Stage Employees and Motion Picture Technicians Union (I.A.T.S.E.) Local 16. From 2003-2006 I worked as a Stage Electrician for The San Francisco Opera. In the off seasons working on Feature Films and Commercials. At the end of my tenure at the SF Opera I began working for George Lucas's Industrial Light & Magic (ILM) and stayed on when Kerner Optical took over their stages until their closing. From 2010-2016, I left the Motion Picture world to develop a Still Photography studio with Restoration Hardware (RH). Where I directed Studio Support Services of the catalog production team for the Vice President of Creative Operations, Vladimir Simovich. At RH I was responsible for several operational aspects of photo production: Electrical Power Distribution, Overhead Rigging, Lighting and Grip, Safety, Equipment Purchasing, Rental, Repair and Maintenance, Metal Fabrication and Design, Employee Training/Mentoring, Liaising with Vendors, Outside Contractors, and other departments in the company outside of Photo Production. There were 38 stages under my purview in the Bay Area. 12 stages in Corte Madera, and 12 stages in Richmond using "Hot Lights" (AKA Motion Picture Tungsten and HMI Lighting) for interior sets and 14 Stages in Pinole, using Strobe Lighting for Web Photography and Catalog Inserts. At various points for Outdoor Catalog photography in addition to what was happening in the three studio's I was responsible for outfitting, on-demand servicing, and logistics for simultaneous deployments of two location teams in Northern California and three location teams in Southern California.
